 - Please check your child's backpack each day for artwork, notes, and other important information.

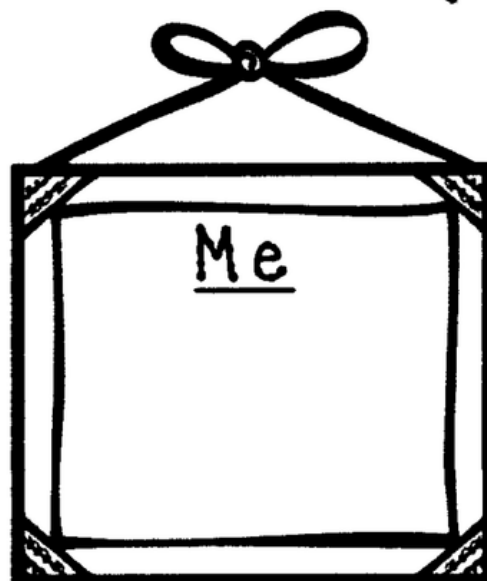
