- Sleeping bags and folders will be sent home each Friday. Please return them on Monday.
- Homework: A simple worksheet related to our weekly lesson will be sent home each Friday to complete over the weekend.
- Birthday celebrations: You're welcome to send in a nut-free treat for your child's birthday. Please check with me in advance so we can plan a special celebration together!
