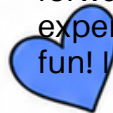
I can't wait to get to know each of you and make this school year full of learning, laughter, and wonderful memories. I am looking forward to an amazing year together!

Important Information

- We are a **peanut-free facility**. Please be mindful of this when packing food from home.
- Red folders will be sent home daily. Please check and empty your child's folder each day for homework, notices, important papers, and notes from us.
- Homework will be sent home on Mondays and is due on Fridays.
- Our monthly Snapshot, calendar, and lunch menu will be sent home with important notices and information about upcoming activities. **Please review the menu each month.** If you know your child will not eat a particular lunch being served, you are welcome to send an alternate lunch from home for that day.
- Please don't hesitate to reach out with any questions or concerns. We will work promptly to address any issues that may arise and are always happy to help.
- We will be sending an invitation to join the Band App. This is our primary form of communication with families. Please accept the invitation as soon as possible. - ☐ 1 pack of Expo fine-tip dry erase markers (assorted colors)
